Seeing that in the world controversies constantly arise due to ignorance of boundaries , he should...have ...concealed boundary markers buried-stones, bones, cows hair, chaff, ashes , potsherds, dries cow dung, bricks, coal, pebbles and sand. He should also have other similar substances that would not decay in the soil buried as hidden markers at the intersections of boundaries.


