Proceedings

Welcome

The Chairperson welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Confirmation of minutes of previous meeting

The Chairperson enquired about receipt of minutes of the previous meeting held on 29th September, 2017 (on the occasion of 1st semester report day) and the action taken report which were already sent to the members in advance. The members confirmed the receipt of the same.

The action taken report was read out for the purpose of clarity and comfort of the members about action taken by the school (teachers/staff concerned).

The members being satisfied with recording of minutes and the action taken report, the same was confirmed by the Chair.

Progress report of the 2nd quarter and some photographic glimpses

- Children are finishing their fruits and tiffin.
- **Madam Director informed the members that fruit break was carried on successfully in JBS and now it has started in JB Academy and Montessori.**
- Session on child abuse was taken from Nursery to class IV

Suggestions

The feed-back about the activities of the 2nd quarter and suggestions for further improvement were as follows:

- Transportation facility should be given
- **Madam Director disagreed for the facility as only few parents were ready and further it was not feasible to give the bus facility**
- Disaster Management drill should be organized
- **Principal explained the system and briefed the members how it is held**
- It was suggested that the guard could note down the number of the vehicles which are not parked properly. The signature of that person should be taken
- **Madam Director stated that parents co-operation is paramount for carrying out the rules. She added that the children are being taught to follow the rules and are motivating their parents for the same**
- Members appreciated the measures taken up by the school on the safety of children
- In 'Food' project it would have been systematic if the children saw the crops in the field and later they could be exposed to FCI
- **Discussed with the teachers**

- Children are losing interest in Hindi and are not studying it willingly
- **Teachers were further asked to make the Hindi class interesting**

- On the Annual Sports Day there should be some races for the parents too
- Parents should also be involved on Bal Mela
- **It will be followed in the next session**
- **The whole process of diagnostic test was explained by Madam Director. The purpose and the way how it is taken up was shared**

- Children should know how to give first aid as it prevents the condition from worsening
- **Madam Director ensured the members that it will be included in the life skill curriculum and will be followed**

- Zero period should be there for games classes
- **It will be implemented from the next session**

- Members appreciated the global exposure given to the children and complimented the learnings
- Speech therapist should be there for special children
