

Mixing Colours

The white colour is a mixture of the colours of the spectrum. A mixture of two colours is a third colour.


You need:

- Cardboard
- Yellow and blue paper
- String
- Scissors

How the experiment is performed?

- 1. Cut out a cardboard circle.
- Stick blue paper on one side and yellow on the other.
- 3. Drill two small holes opposite to each other close to the circle's edge.
- 4. Thread the string through the holes and hold the ends as shown.
- 5. Rotate the circle by rolling the string between your fingers. Which colour will you see as the circle rotates?





What will happen?


The colour you will see is green.

Why?

As you rotate the circle, the colours fuse with each other – your eye retains the impression of a colour only for a brief moment after it vanishes.

Additional idea!

Make another circle and pierce two small holes somewhat nearer its centre. Stick quarter – circles of blue and red paper as shown. Roll the string's two ends between your fingers for a while and then pull them away from each other, spinning the circle. Which colour do you see?
