Take a product having seasonal growth and regular demand with which students can relate. For example, Apples from Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir. Oranges from Nagpur, Mangoes from

Maharashtra/U.P./Bihar/Andhra Pradesh etc. Strawberries from Panchgani, Aloe vera from Rajasthan, Walnuts/almonds from Kashmir, Jackfruit from South, Guavas from Allahabad, Pineapples from North East India, Tea from Assam, Orchids from Sikkim and Meghalaya, Pottery of Manipur, Fishes from coastal areas.

Students may develop a Case Study on the following lines:

- (i) Research for change in price of the product. For example, apples in Himachal Pradesh during plucking and non plucking season.
- (ii) Effect on prices in the absence of an effective transport system.
- (iii) Effect on prices in the absence of suitable warehouse facilities.
- (iv) Duties performed by the warehouses.
- (v) Demand and supply situation of the product during harvesting season, prices near the place of origin and away.

Students may find out the importance of producing and selling these products and their processed items along with the roles of Transport, Warehousing, Advertising, Banking, Insurance, Packaging, Wholesale selling, Retailing, Co-operative farming, Co-operative marketing etc.
