Chapter-1 Tracing Changes Through a Thousand Years (History)

Map Activity:

Mark major dynasties (Cholas, Mughals, Guptas, etc.) on a blank map of India and show where new technologies (like Persian wheel, spinning wheel, firearms) appeared.

Short Report:
